Dr Liong pursued a degree in medicine at the National University of Malaysia and graduated at the top of his class with the only honours degree in medicine conferred for the year. He also obtained various other awards including the university gold medal and a gold medal in medicine amongst others.

Upon graduation, Dr Liong did his house job in Klang Hospital and was subsequently posted to the state of Pahang. His busy clinical posts gave a very comprehensive experience in medicine, surgery, obstetrics and gynaecology, intensive care and orthopedics.

Dr Liong subsequently decided on a career in radiology due to his interests in a wide spectrum of clinical specialties and application of advances technology in patient care. He underwent further training in clinical radiology at the University of Malaysia which led to the degree of Masters of Medicine in Radiology. Whilst in training he also found time to take the Royal College of Radiologists examinations successfully and was admitted as a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists (UK) whilst still in training.
